Definitions

Ended Homelessness – With FP assistance, homeless family secured their own home. The family may have been living in a shelter, vehicle, hotel, tent or doubled up.

Prevented Homelessness – FP prevented homelessness by assisting family to keep them in their home

FP Residential – Resident of FP and then graduated to their own home

Stability Services – Received stability services such as gas cards, utility assistance, food, child care, furniture, budgeting, life skills, car repairs and much more.

Total Crisis Calls – 1,104 (60% increase from 2018)
